





When he did eventually say sorry his brother forgave him.</i> <i>How do we feel when we’ve had an argument or done something wrong? How do we put it right?</i></p> <p>Having the Humility to Say Sorry. Important theme during Lent that we repent and know that God forgives us.</p>	<p>The importance of saying Sorry. Have you ever forgiven anyone? Have you ever needed to be forgiven?</p> <p>It takes humility to own up to being wrong.
